WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Applicants must be an individual with autism or a parent, legal guardian or grandparent of individual with autism.
- Applicants must complete both pages of the scholarship request form.
- Only one scholarship will be awarded per family.
- Recipients must register and attend the full 2-day conference (*see Registration form for fees*).
- Scholarships will be paid to recipients after the conference.
- A limited number of \$50 scholarships are available on a first-come, first serve basis.
- Applicants are responsible for making own transportation and lodging arrangements.
- Applications will be accepted until October 15, 2009.
- Incomplete scholarship applications will be returned to sender.

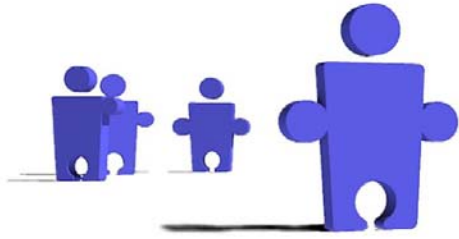
